


POWERCLEAN[™] Drum Vacuum



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING YOUR CANISTER VACUUM.

Unplug from outlet when not in use and before conducting maintenance. When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should be observed, including the following:

WARNING TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR INJURY:

- » Connect to a properly grounded outlet only. See grounding instructions. Do not modify the 3-prong grounded plug.
- » Do not leave vacuum cleaner when it is plugged in.
- » Unplug from outlet when not in use and before servicing.
- » Do not expose to rain, store indoors.
- » Intended primarily for indoor use and occasional outdoor use.
- » Do not freeze.
- » Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- » Plastic film can be dangerous. To avoid danger of suffocation, keep away from children.
- » Do not use for any purpose other than described in this User's Guide. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- » Do not plug in your vacuum cleaner until you are familiar with all instructions and operating procedures.
- » To reduce the risk of electrical shock, turn power switch off and disconnect polarized

plug from electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.

- » Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, have it repaired at an authorized service center.
- » Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners.
- » Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- » Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- » Do not handle plug or vacuum cleaner with wet hands.
- » Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep openings free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- » Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- » Turn off all controls before plugging or unplugging vacuum cleaner.
- » Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.

- » Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible materials (lighter fluid, gasoline, kerosene, etc.) or use in areas where they may be present.
- » Do not use vacuum cleaner in an enclosed space filled with vapors given off by oil base paint, paint thinner, some moth proofing substances, flammable dust, or other explosive or toxic vapors.
- » Do not use to pick up toxic material (chlorine bleach, ammonia, drain cleaner, etc.).
- » Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- » Do not pick up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws, coins, etc.
- » Keep appliance on a level surface.
- » Do not carry the appliance while in use.
- » This product should not be used with detergents or to pick up foaming wet messes to prevent internal component damage.
- » Do not immerse. Use only on surfaces moistened by the cleaning process.
- » Do not use without filters in place.
- » Always install float before any wet pick-up operation.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE

This model is for household use only. Commercial use of this unit voids the manufacturer's warranty.

Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electrical shock. Check with a qualified electrician or service person if you aren't sure if the outlet is properly grounded. DO NOT MODIFY THE PLUG. If it will not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician. This appliance is designed for use on a nominal 120-volt circuit, and has a grounding attachment plug that looks like the plug in the illustration. Make certain that the appliance is connected to an outlet having the same configuration as the plug. No plug adapter should be used with this appliance.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This appliance must be connected to a grounded wiring system. If it should malfunction or break down, grounding provides a safe path of least resistance for electrical current, reducing the risk of electrical

shock. The cord for this appliance has an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. It must only be plugged into an outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.







Assembly (Dry Cleaning)


Do not plug in your vacuum until you are familiar with all instructions and operating procedures.




Emptying the Dirt Container

MWARNING

NOTE: If you suffer from allergies, place a plastic bag over top of Dirt Container and tip upside down to empty. Wait for dust to settle, remove bag and discard.




Cleaning the Filters

AWARNING

To reduce the risk of electrical shock, turn power switch OFF and disconnect polarized plug from electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.

Do not operate vacuum with a damp or wet filter, or without filter or the Dirt Container in place. Allow components to dry before reassembling the Dirt Container.



Troubleshooting

RNING

To reduce the risk of electric shock, turn power switch OFF and disconnect plug from electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.

Problem	Possible causes	Remedies
	Filter is dirty.	Remove and rinse Filter. Allow enough time to dry properly before reinserting.
	Main Hose is not connected.	Reconnect the main Hose by pushing the hose connection to secure latch.
	Crack or hole in the main Hose.	If there is a crack or hole, order a new hose from www.BISSELL.com.
Vacuum won't pick	Clog in the Floor Tool.	Remove debris and any other entanglements that may be restricting its rotation.
up dirt	Clog in the Filter.	Remove the Dirt Container Filter assembly and tap it over a rubbish bin to remove any dirt or debris from the cyclone screen that surrounds the filter.
	Clog in the vacuum.	Check to see if there are any clogs in the Suction Inlet.
	Filter is not seated correctly.	Ensure the Filter black portion of the filter is completely on the lip of the metal drum.
	Dirt Container is full.	Empty the Dirt Container.
Dirt is escaping	Filter is missing.	Check to see if Filter is in place.
from the vacuum	Filter is not seated properly.	Ensure the Filter basket is sitting completely on the wall of the Dirt Container all the way around.
